On Friday **December 17th**, log in [here](#) from 4:30-7:00 pm so that we can wish you a happy and safe holiday and to share some cheer.




PLAY FUN GAMES, WIN FUN PRIZES!

GAME 1 - Reindeer Games

Each of the (4) below images has been plotted on a 26 x 26 grid (x axis = A-Z, y axis = 1-26), and the winning coordinates are under strict security MUNACA's satellite office located at the North Pole!

A. Light the Kinara!



*Each day of Kwanzaa is tied to one of the holiday's seven principles: unity (umoja), self-determination (kujichagulia), collective responsibility (ujima), cooperative economics (ujamaa), purpose (nia), creativity (kuumba), and faith (imani). Each day, families bring out corresponding symbols and light a new candle on the kinara (candleholder). On the final day a feast is held, called the karamu.

B) Light the Menorah!



*Hanukkah, also known as the Festival of Lights, is an eight-day celebration. According to the Talmud, there was only enough consecrated oil to re-light the candelabra for one day, yet, miraculously, it remained lit for eight days.

C) Top the Tree!



*Christmas is an annual festival observed primarily on December 25th as a religious and cultural celebration. It is preceded by the season of Advent and initiates the season of Christmastide, which historically in the West lasts twelve days and culminates on Twelfth Night.

D) Make the Clock Strike Midnight!



*The earliest recorded festivities in honour of a new year's arrival dates back some 4,000 years ago, celebrating the first new moon following the vernal equinox – the day in late March with an equal amount of sunlight and darkness – heralded the start of a new year.

This can include New Year's resolutions, personal goals, work achievements, post-pandemic aspirations, etc.


Each entry received will count as 1 oz of champagne and will earn you 1 raffle ticket.

Responses will be tabulated, and prizes will be sent out by the end of day on December 17th.




