


As announced in the September 1st bulletin, we had our final day of Arbitration with the employer on Sept 1st. On September 9th, Me Cavé handed down her decision. Below, you will find a couple of clarifications about the implementation of <u>MUNACA's new Collective</u> <u>Agreement</u>.

We realize that some of the terms we use can be confusing. The mediation process, suggested by the arbitrator prior to arbitration, was an attempt to give the parties a last chance to reach a settlement on their own. Despite coming to a consensus on most of the articles, a complete agreement was not reached, so the Arbitrator made her ruling (an arbitrated settlement) and this decision is binding for both parties, therefore the Collective Agreement will expire on May 31st 2024. The contents of this agreement remain in place until a new agreement is signed.

The employer has 60 working days from the date of the decision to pay out the signing bonuses, and 90 working days from the date of decision to place members on the new salary grid and pay retroactive amounts.


